TYPE OF VOLUNTARY WORK: Visual Arts Committee Members (VAC0618)

The Visual Arts Committee is purely an advisory body and has no legal or constitutional role within the Kendal Brewery Arts Centre Trust Limited.

#### **PURPOSE OF THE ROLE:**

To provide advice, guidance and intelligence on developments within the visual arts field from a local, regional national and international perspective, and to provide practical thoughts and suggestions for the programme at the Brewery.

#### **COMMITTEE COMPOSITION:**

The committee is composed of:

Brewery Representatives - Chief Executive (and/or Visual Arts Officer)

Visual Arts Development Officer (Brewery Youth Arts)

Other Representatives - 3 Professional Visual Artists – with an emphasis on representing a

diversity of backgrounds and a wide range of art forms and technical

approaches

2 Curators or other professionals working closely within the visual

arts field

1 Arts Educational Specialist

Support - Administrative support for the committee will be supplied by the

Brewery's Visual Arts Administrator

Co-option - The committee may choose to co-opt a person onto the Committee

for the duration of a project, if they bring specialist knowledge or skills to the committee. Their temporary membership will be reviewed at six monthly intervals until the group deem the project is

complete or the co-opted member resigns from or becomes a full

member of the committee.

#### **MEETINGS:**

The Visual Arts Committee will meet no more than four times a year for main meetings. Additional attendance at working group meetings, previews etc. would be welcomed but at the committee members discretion.

Attendance at more than 60% of main committee meetings is required per annum.
