

# Brewery Membership – Terms & Conditions

1. *Brewery Membership* is a donor-scheme with financial and non-financial benefits, which are determined by and at the discretion of BAC in return for a fixed annual fee. Being part of *Brewery Membership* does not extend to any aspect of the management or governance of BAC, the Kendal Brewery Arts Centre Trust Limited (KBACTL) and its subsidiary KCC.
2. *Brewery Membership* is valid for one year from the date of purchase.
3. *Brewery Membership* discounts cannot be applied retrospectively to tickets already purchased.
4. *Brewery Membership* is valid only for the named holder and is non-transferable and non-exchangeable.
5. *Brewery Membership* benefits can not be used in conjunction with any other offer or promotion. All offers are subject to availability.
6. The free two cinema tickets are for the member use only and are provided only on the first year of joining the scheme. They cannot be redeemed against live screenings and designated special film presentations. Season list of exclusions is available on request. If a membership is lapsed for 12 months or more before the member rejoins they will then be considered a new member and will receive the two cinema tickets on joining.
7. *Brewery Membership* cannot be used to obtain a discount when buying a Family Ticket for a film screening or live event.
8. Individual members are entitled to one reduced rate per ticketed arts event or film screening *Brewery Membership* is operated by: The Kendal Brewery Arts Centre, 122a Highgate, Kendal, Cumbria, LA9 4HE (owned and operated by the Kendal Brewery Arts Centre Trust Limited – registered charity 01086789) referred to hereafter as BAC and our catering Kendal Catering Company referred to hereafter as KCC.
9. Normal ticketing conditions, including a booking fee, apply.
10. 10% Cinema discount on *Brewery Membership* applies only to full price Adult Tickets (currently £8.50) and Silver Screenings (currently £7.50). The following are excluded from Cinema tickets and discounts: Silver Film Parties, Cinema Bambino, Reel Deal, Students, Under 16's & 17-24 are already discounted –. Also, any events that are one-offs (such as the opening night of the Japan film Week) will also be excluded from the `BMC`. Any special event screenings with an alternative price band are excluded from the Membership offer.
11. The two complimentary cinema tickets are issued to those who join *Brewery Membership* for the first time. It does not apply to renewals. Unless 12 months or more have passed.
12. £6 cinema tickets are available for all members on Sundays.
13. To become a member, you must be 18 or over. If you are under 18, please ask a parent or guardian to register and remain liable on your behalf.

14. By signing up for *Brewery Membership* you give your consents to receiving membership communications from the Kendal Brewery Arts Centre Trust Limited relating to your membership. Members` details will not be passed on to any third parties without your permission outside those required to operate the scheme.
15. *Brewery Membership* is entitled to 10% off the total food bill when ordering in the Bar and Restaurant. All drinks and beverages are excluded from this offer. Only one membership discount can apply per meal bill on a table of a maximum of 6 people.
16. Food purchases in the Cinema Counter (except for the Brewery Membership Cinema Combo) are not included. All drinks and beverage are excluded. Doesn't apply to seasonal and special promotions, set menus such as Christmas, Valentines, Mother's Day and any other bespoke menu offered throughout the year,
17. 30% on room hire applies to Room 14 Meeting Room. Subject to availability and must be booked in advance. Based on a minimum of 20 people ordering from our buffet menu.
18. Complimentary Birthday Cake for the member when he or she books their celebration in the Restaurant only. Strictly one complimentary cake per year when you book a children's film party (caters for an average of eight people).
19. Food and cinema counter offers subject to availability and levels of stock at the time of the offer. Combo offers are only available to the Brewery member.

21. The Kendal Brewery Arts Centre Trust Limited and KCC reserve the right to withdraw any offers within the *Brewery Membership* benefits at anytime.
