About the course

Got a chair that's looking a bit threadbare? You could send it to an upholsterer, but think how much more satisfying it would be to have restored and up cycle it yourself? This course will get you started.

This 10 week course will cover reupholstering a Modern chair following the basics Modern upholstery methods this will include the correct use of tools and fabric. The course is aimed at a beginner or someone who would like to learn Modern upholstery skills.

What will the course cover and how will it be taught?

During the course you will learn:

- the basic principles of Modern upholstery depending on what furniture you work on; webbing, stuffing, re-covering.
- about upholstery tools and sundries.
- measuring up and cutting out of fabric

Your tutor will discuss the course content with the class and may make some adjustments to the syllabus based on the needs of the group. She will also try to accommodate individual requirements where possible.

What do I need to bring with me?

The Course includes the use of all the upholstery tools required to reupholster your chair. You will be provided with a starter kit of material at a cost of £15.00 additional materials can also be purchased on the day. You will also need to bring a drop in or pin stuffed seat and top fabric. If you do not have a chair or fabric the tutor can supply them for you at additional fee.

What can I do next?

The Brewery has an excellent range of learning experiences with the emphasis on enjoyment, social interaction and personal development.
