OVERALL PURPOSE OF THE ROLE:

Along with a small existing team, assist with the maintenance and ad hoc improvements of the Brewery Arts garden.

MAIN TASKS

- Pruning, shearing and shaping plants and shrubs
- Planting of plants and shrubs
- Removal of weeds, plants and shrubs
- Edging of borders
- Cleaning up garden areas including removal of litter
- Raking and sweeping
- Minimal hard landscaping
- Cleaning tools
- Maintenance and tidying gardeners shed

Note - No grass cutting as this is carried out by our Facilities Manager.

INTERESTS, SKILLS AND ABILITIES:

We are looking for a volunteer who has the following interests, skills and abilities:

- An interest in helping Brewery Arts charity
- A commitment to regularly attend garden sessions
- Ability to carry out instructions given regarding tasks to be completed in the garden
- Physical ability to carry out general gardening duties including: lifting; bending; kneeling and sweeping
- Ability to identify plants and know what to do with them
- Some gardening experience whether professional or personal
- Safety awareness for themselves and the general public
